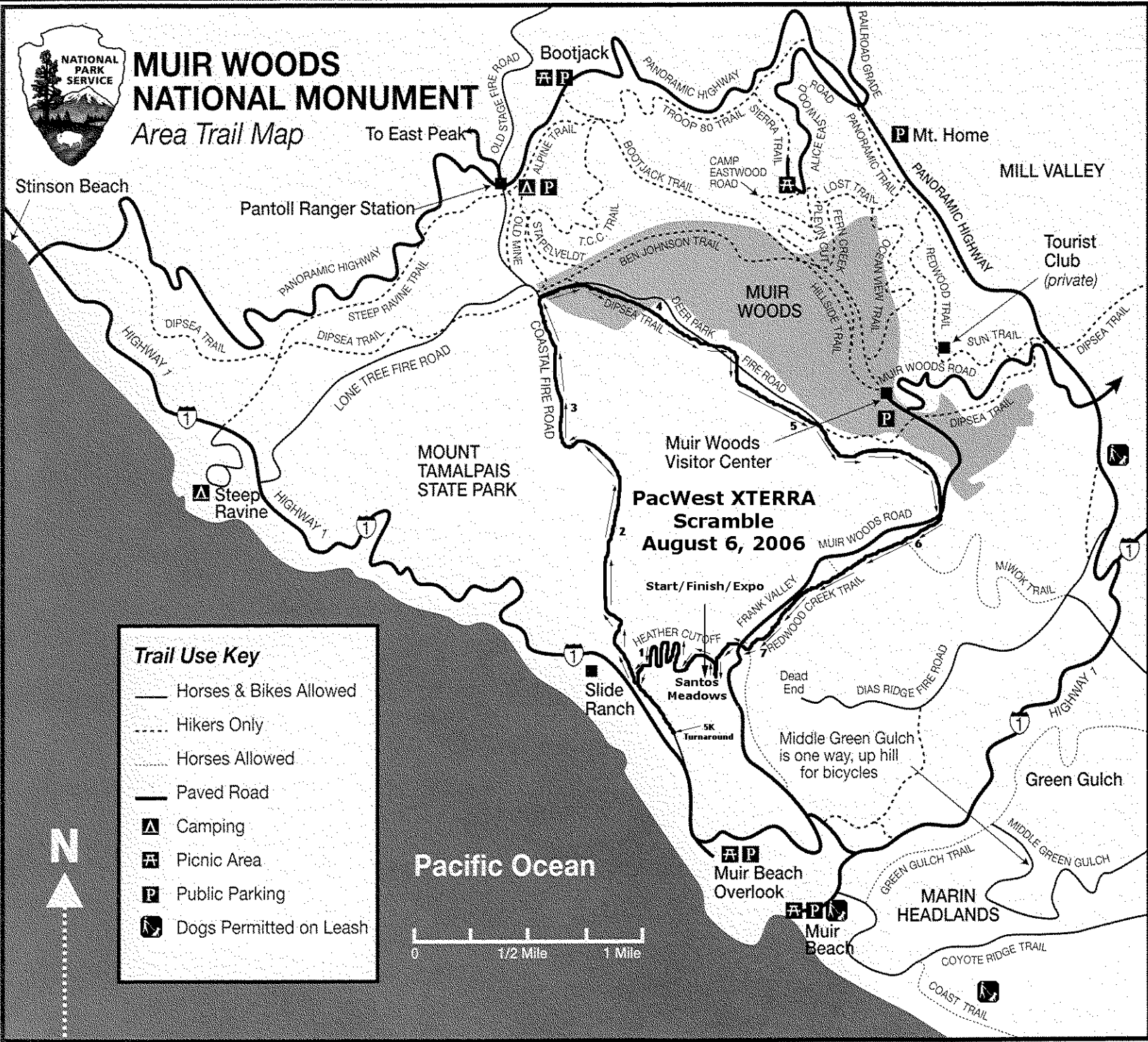




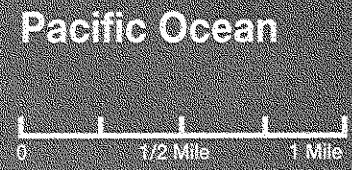
MUIR WOODS NATIONAL MONUMENT

Trail Rules

- Muir Woods is closed to bicycles, dogs, camping and picnics.
- Always carry water and a map.
- Shortcuts cause erosion. Please stay on the trail.
- Bikes are only allowed on fire roads. Cyclists may not exceed 15 MPH and must slow to 5MPH around corners or while passing other trail users. Helmets strongly recommended.
- Dog walkers must obey regulations and pick up after their pet.
- Please protect your national and state parks. Take only pictures.
